

Dear Participants,

As GProCongress II approaches, we need to clarify an important matter regarding visa processing for those planning to attend from outside Panama. We want to emphasize that uploading your passport information on the <u>gprocongress.org</u> website DOES NOT mean that RREACH is processing the visa application to Panama on your behalf. We need that information regarding your planned arrival at the Congress to assist us in preparing for your attendance. <u>To obtain a visa, you will be required to initiate and complete the visa process yourself</u>.

To initiate the visa process, you must take the following steps:

1. Contact the Panamanian embassy or consulate in your country or region as soon as possible. They will guide you through the visa application process and provide you with the procedure you need to follow. Please visit https://mire.gob.pa/ministerio/embajadasyconsulados for the locations and contact information of Panamanian embassies around the world.

2. While we cannot directly process your visa, we are providing two supporting documents that will help you with your application. These documents will serve as evidence to support your visa application and demonstrate your participation in the GProCongress. We have also given you a list of the documents needed to apply for your visa, as well as the visa form application you must give to the embassy.

3. If you are traveling from a restricted visa country, the immigration department will schedule an appointment for you to submit your visa application and complete the necessary formalities. Please be prepared to follow all of their instructions and guidelines. When you send us your passport and personal details, a member of our team will contact you to guide you in the process.

We understand that visa processing can be a complex and time-consuming process. Therefore, we recommend initiating the application procedure well in advance to ensure a smooth and timely process. If you have questions or need assistance during the visa application process, please reach out to our dedicated support team. We are here to provide guidance and support to make your journey to the GProCongress as seamless as possible.
